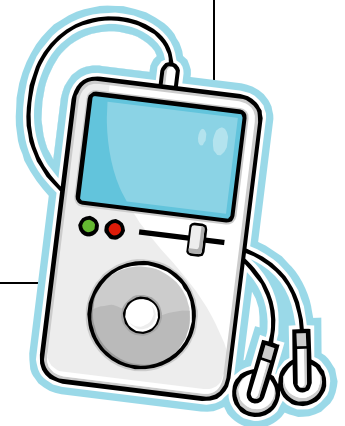

Maine's GEAR UP Program is helping to create a sustainable culture in schools that supports students who are economically disadvantaged in preparing for, accessing, and succeeding in postsecondary education.

Objectives

GEAR UP Maine is working to ensure:

- All 8th grade students develop proficient algebraic skills.
- All high school students take college courses.
- All students have personal learning plans that include a postsecondary component which are shared at a student-led parent-teacher conference.
- All students and their families participate in student-led conferences.
- All seniors complete at least one application to attend a postsecondary school and file a FAFSA.
- All schools increase the number of rigorous courses, including AP and college courses.
- All schools promote high aspirations for all students by facilitating student engagement and achievement in a supportive learning environment.
