GEAR UP-The BIG Picture

The Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (GEAR UP) initiative three strategic goals:

- (1) increasing the postsecondary expectations and readiness of students;
- (2) improving high school graduation and postsecondary enrollment rates; and
- (3) raising the knowledge of postsecondary options, preparation, and financing among students and families.

GEAR UP-The BIG Picture

GEAR UP serves over 560,000 students enrolled in over 3,525 secondary schools across 45 states.

There are 39 State grants and 122 Partnership grants.

GEAR UP services focus on academic, social, and planning support as students' progress from the middle grades through high school graduation, and into the first year of college.

GEAR UP services include professional development for instructors and counselors, improving the quality and intensity of secondary school courses, mentoring, tutoring, scholarships and financial aid, college and career planning, and parental engagement programs designed to support college planning and enrollment.

GEAR UP Maine

GEAR UP Maine grant was awarded to UMF Maine in September 2014, ending in September 2021.

GEAR UP Maine serves just under 10,000 students in grades 7-12 enrolled in 24 districts across the state.

GEAR UP Maine also provides support to students in the class of 2020 as they transition from high school into Institutions of Higher Education in Maine.

Request for Reimbursement-

- Once data is complete in SCRIBE by district Data Steward, the Data Steward will generate an Activity Summary Sheet from SCRIBE.
- All services in SCRIBE must have a
 Downloaded Activity Summary Sheets from
 Scribe to accompany an invoice for
 reimbursement.

Invoicing Refresher cont.,

- Use PDF's for all attachments/uploads to Scribe
- Reminder- Benefits are included in overall contract amount for salaries. Example- a Data Steward stipend is \$3000, this amount can not be exceeded in reimbursements from GU.
- Clearly visible receipts- please label with service!
- Ideal sample receipt- Activity name on receipt

Quarterly Status Updates: GEAR UP Maine will provide superintendents and CAT leads quarterly updates on district plans, invoicing, and data. *GEAR UP Maine will communicate any decisions on budget reallocations based on the district status to superintendents and CAT leads.*

Q1 Closes October 30, 2019- Report to Districts by November 30, 2019- Informed of any budget adjustments December 30, 2019

Q2 Closes January 30, 2020- Report to Districts by February 28- Districts informed of any budget adjustments by March 30, 2020.

Q3 Closes April 30, 2020- Report to Districts by May 30, 2020- Districts informed of any final YR 6 budget adjustments by June 30, 2020.
