Participants will:

- Work with the GEAR UP and MXH Marketing teams

- Build media, communication, and storytelling skills

This ELO runs for one semester. You may apply for Fall or Spring. We are accepting only 2 to 3 students per term.

Every Day Counts!

Let's stay on track together! In Maine, about 25% of students miss 10% or more of the school year (almost 20 days) and these missed days can lead to challenges in learning and staying engaged.

Absences often stem from real-life issues like illness, mental health, or unstable housing and not by choice.

You can make a big difference by encouraging your student to attend every day possible and by working with us to address any barriers that come up.
